THE SCIENCE OF SUBTLE ENERGIES

The earth is crisscrossed with lines of very low frequency energies called telluric currents, caused by magnetic fields, underground streams, veins of metals, etc. (Source: Harmonic 33, Harmonic 695 by Captain Bruce Cathie.)

Some individuals are able to sense these energies using instruments such as dowsing rods or pendulums, or simply through their bare hands.

Since the beginning of the scientific age, the ability to perceive subtle energies was regarded as a superstition.

However, today, science is beginning to validate these practices.

HOW DOWSING WORKS

Divining rods and all common dowsing devices are the simplest forms of electroscopes.

The divining rods are charged with static electricity from the dowser's own body.

This static electricity can be measured with a simple millivolt meter.

The amount of voltage will vary depending on the person. A good dowser will have a high reading, above 100 mv, while a poor dowser may read as low as 0 mv.

- Researchers analyzed the successes and failures of dowsers in attempting to locate water at more than 2000 sites in arid regions of Sri Lanka, Zaire, Kenya, Namibia and Yemen over a 10-year period.
- To do this, researchers teamed geological experts with experienced dowsers and then set up a scientific study group to evaluate the results.
- Drill crews guided by dowsers didn't hit water every time, but their success rate was impressive.
- In Sri Lanka, for example, they drilled 691 holes and had an overall success rate of 96 percent.





INTRODUCTION

Telluric currents consist of both the natural electric currents flowing within the Earth, including the oceans, and the electric currents originating from man-made systems. Telluric currents could also be considered to include geodynamo currents, i.e., the electric currents that are presumed to flow in the Earth's core and are responsible for the generation of the "permanent" geomagnetic field. This review excludes geodynamo considerations from its purview.

There has been an evolution (see Appendix) in the terminology in the English-language scientific literature related to telluric currents. A common former term used for telluric currents has been "Earth currents." a term that was widely used by Chapman and Bartels (1940) in their classic work, whereas Price (1967) preferred "telluric currents." A difference between the two terms can be recognized in reading historical papers: an impression is obtained that Earth's currents was the name applied to the natural currents (or, more properly, voltages) that are measured between two electrodes which are grounded at some distance apart. Independent of the cause, the observed current was termed an Earth's current. It later became evident that electric currents also flow in seawater. Therefore, the term telluric currents can be interpreted to include currents flowing both within the solid Earth and within the seas and oceans. However, we note that Earth currents and ocean currents do not form independent electric-current systems. On the contrary, leakage currents exist between continental areas and oceans (see, e.g., references in Gregori and Lanzerotti, 1982; Jones, 1983). In the early French and Italian scientific literature on the subject, however, the term telluric (derived from the Latin tellus, for Earth) was always used (e.g., Blavier, 1884; Battelli, 1888; Moureaux, 1896).

The fundamental causes of telluric currents are now believed to be understood. They are produced either through electromagnetic induction by the time-varying, external-origin geomagnetic field or whenever a conducting body (such as seawater) moves (because of tides or other reason) across the Earth's permanent magnetic field soft both causes produce telluric currents, which, in turn, produce magnetic fields of their ownfields that add to the external origin geomagnetic field and produce a feedback on the ionosphere current system (a feedback that, however, is negligible; see, e.g., Malin, 1970).

The complexities associated with telluric currents arise from the complexities in the external sources and in the conductivity structure of the Earth itself. Such complexities have led earlier workers to make statements such as "the simple laws of electromagnetic induction do

A **telluric current** (from Latin *tellūs*, "earth") is an <u>electric current</u> which moves underground or through the sea. Telluric currents result from both natural causes and human activity, and the discrete currents interact in a complex pattern. The currents are <u>extremely low frequency</u> and travel over large areas at or near the surface of the Earth.

Telluric currents are phenomena observed in the Earth's <u>crust</u> and <u>mantle</u>. Telluric currents flow in the surface layers of the earth. The electric potential on the Earth's surface can be measured at different points, enabling us to calculate the magnitudes and directions of the telluric currents and thence the Earth's <u>conductance</u>.

Both the telluric and <u>magnetotelluric</u> methods are used for exploring the structure beneath the Earth's surface (such as in industrial prospecting). For <u>mineral</u> exploration the targets are conductive <u>ore</u> bodies. Other uses include exploration of <u>geothermal</u> fields, <u>petroleum</u> reservoirs, fault zones, ground water, <u>magma</u> chambers, and <u>plate tectonic</u> boundaries. Telluric currents can be harnessed to produce a useful low voltage current by means of <u>earth batteries</u>. Such devices were used for <u>telegraph</u> systems in the United States as far back as 1859.

STANDING STONES, TEMPLES AND CHURCHES SITED OVER ENERGY SPOTS ON THE EARTH'S SURFACE

Two types of spots on the Earth's surface, which a dowser can detect with dowsing rods, a pendulum or bare hands.

ENERGY SPOTS SACRED SPOTS



The Masons who sited, designed and constructed the city of Washington, DC knew where the energy spots were!




There is an energy spot under the dome of the Capitol and inside the Building Museum.

One instrument dowsers use is a pendulum.


The pendulum can be used to detect energy spots and also to get answers to questions.

Old methods of access to spiritual world are not appropriate.


We will return with our own conscious efforts—Parable of the Prodigal Son.

A RECENT STUDY ON ENERGY HEALING

Study by Dolores Krieger, nurse and teacher at New York University.


- 1. Clear the aura of negative energy.

- 8. Direct the subject to the Joy of Living!
